FEBRUARY VESTRY UPDATE

-- **Mission Beyond:** Two representatives will be attending a municipal meeting looking at solutions to homelessness in Fredericton. Two new clients have been added to their active list.

--**Mission Within:** Several projects and activities are underway: Lenten Study, "Noticing God" will held Sunday evenings at 6 pm, beginning March 12; an Ash Wednesday Program; Men's Breakfast, Ladies Tea and Dinner at the Mandarin are scheduled for the Spring; PAC is organizing the Pancake Supper.

--**Finance:** Financial Report was reviewed and although it is early in the year our finances appear to be on target. The amount scheduled to be taken out of investments will be reduced as reflected in our end of year financial statement.

--**Building and Grounds:** There is a window in the Chapel Vestry which requires repair. Money in the Restoration Fund has been allocated for this and it is to be done when the weather is warmer. The Committee reviewing the heating system is focusing on the heating controls. There are seven thermostats in the building and they date back at least four generations. The furnace itself is working properly. Further reports will be forthcoming.

--**Other Business:** A review of the parameters of the new Safe Church Policy was presented; a Committee to study this was set up. An application for funding for a Student Tour Guide has been made; a committee was set up to find ways to increase the profile of our chapel for the public. Vestry appointed a Parish Advisory Committee consisting of the following members: Darren Hanscomb, Ann Morgan, Michael Blizzard, Doug Cawker, Nancy Cook. This Committee is appointed every year and called to action by the Bishop only if there is a need to search for a new Rector.
